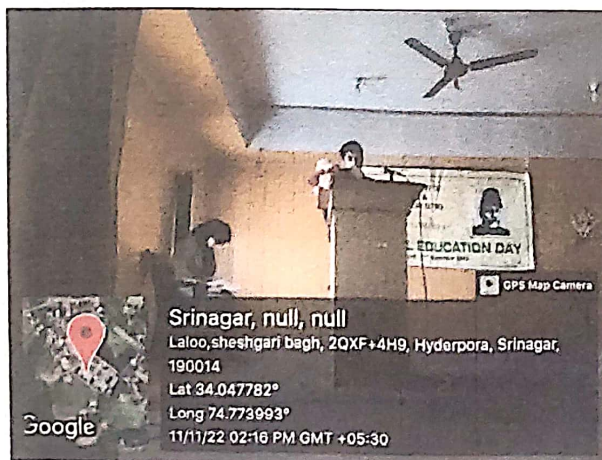

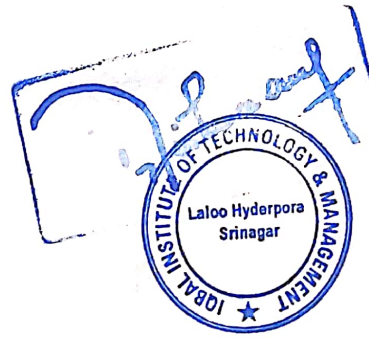
REPORT ON FUN FAIR ORGANIZED BY IITM COLLEGE.

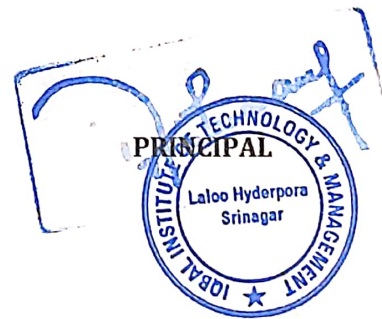
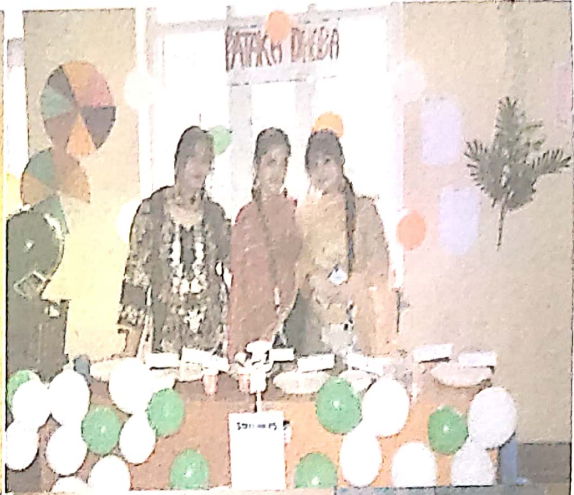
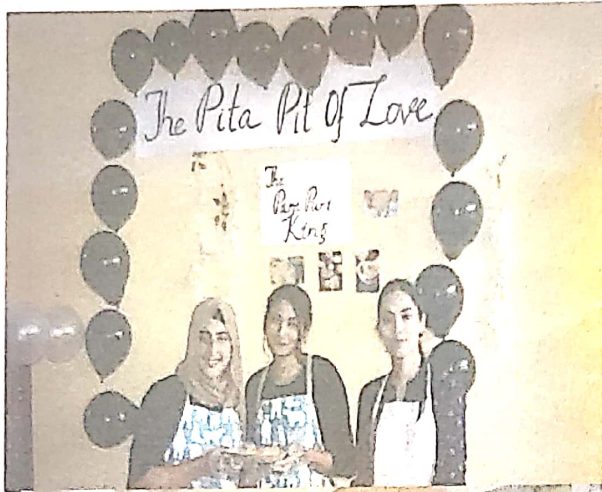

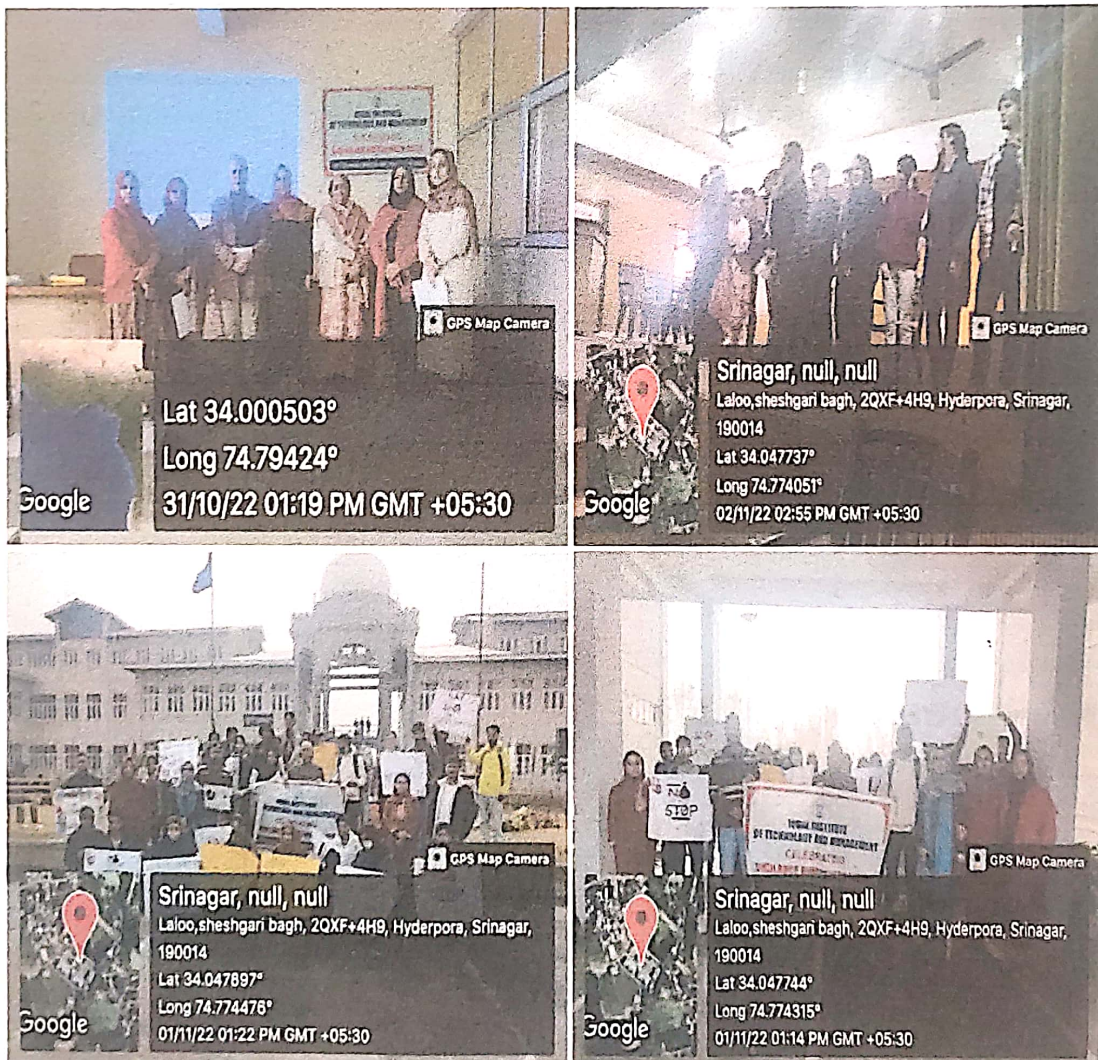


VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK

Feedback and Reactions:

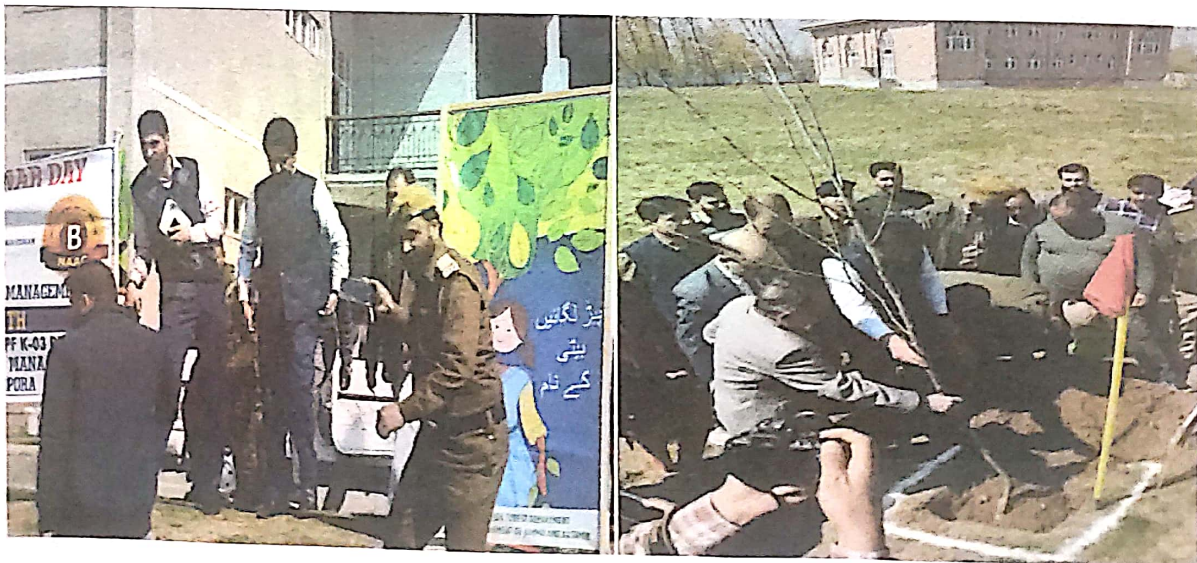

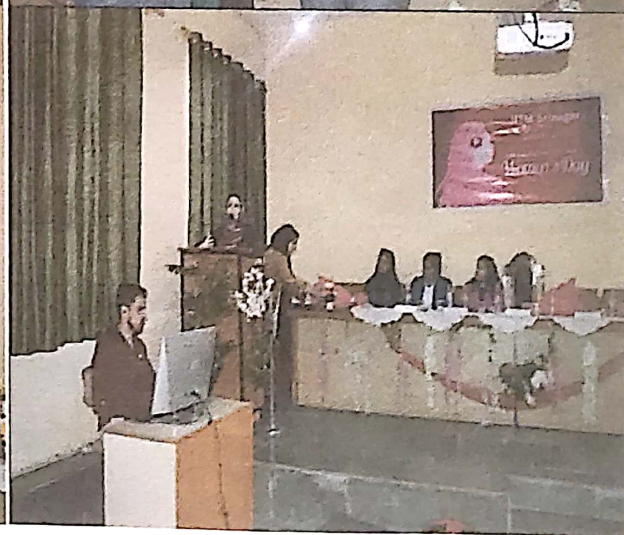
