PROJECTS

 Micro Financing and Case Study on Shri Mahila Griha Udyog Lijat Pappad (2016)

This study showcased a detailed concept of Micro financing & self-help groups in India and aimed to check whether micro financing has supported and empowered women in India. This project involved a case study of Shri Mahila Griha Udyog Lijjat Papad and studied its growth over years. The results showed that there has been an evident growth in revenue from Rs.16,587 to 8 billion since its inception till 2018. Also, Lijjat Papad led to an exceptional growth of women belonging to weaker section of the society. It raised employment from 7 women in 1959 to 43000 women in 2018.

• Determinants of economic growth of BRICS countries (2022)
