IITM ANNUAL DEBATE – 2024

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The debate will be conducted in the English language only.
- 2. Participants must be bonafide students of the participating institution, enrolled in undergraduate or postgraduate courses of study.
- 3. Each participating University/Campus/College/Department/Institute is entitled to send only one team of two speakers: one speaking FOR and another speaking AGAINST the motion.
- 4. The IITM Rolling Trophy will be awarded to the best team based on the combined scores of both participants.
- 5. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
- 6. Each speaker will be allowed to speak for 5+1 minutes only (minimum time limit 5 minutes, maximum time limit 6 minutes). Negative marks will be given to those who exceed or fall below the time limit.
- 7. A jury consisting of three judges will evaluate the speaker's performance based on the following criteria:

a		Logical reasoning and content presented by the speaker	
b	Manner /Style	Voice modulation (including suitable use of accents), presentation delivery and style	50 marks
c	Method/ Strategy	Structure and organization of speeches	50 marks

- 8. The verdict of the judges will be final and binding upon all, No protests or objections regarding the decision or the procedure will be entertained.
- 9. Admission to the debate will be subject to the presentation of a letter of credentials from the head of the institution certifying the bonafide status of the participants. Identity cards with photographs signed by the appropriate authorities of the respective Institutions/Departments/Colleges should also be carried by the participants.
- 10. The speaking order of the participating teams shall be decided based on a draw of lots.
- 11. Participants may be accompanied by a teacher-in-charge and 4 to 5 students to support their team during the debate.
- 12. Paper reading will not be entertained in any case.
- 13. Registration IS on first-come, first-serve basis, subject to the availability of seats.
- 14. Participants are required to focus their arguments on specific policies or decisions rather than criticizing the government or engaging in any discourse that may be perceived as opposing national interests. Any violation of this rule, such as statements undermining national interests, could lead to disqualification.
